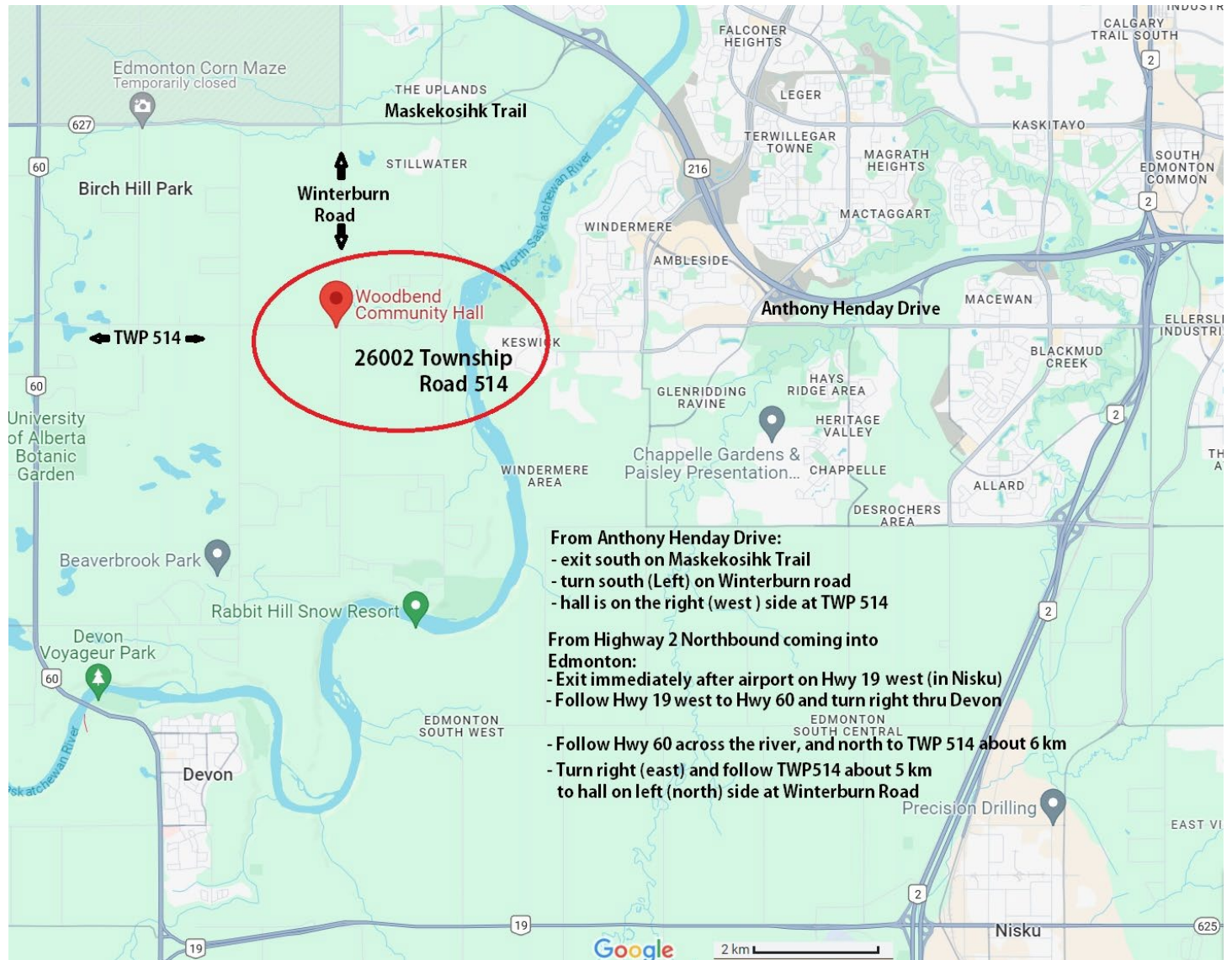


Figure 1: Location of Woodbend Hall

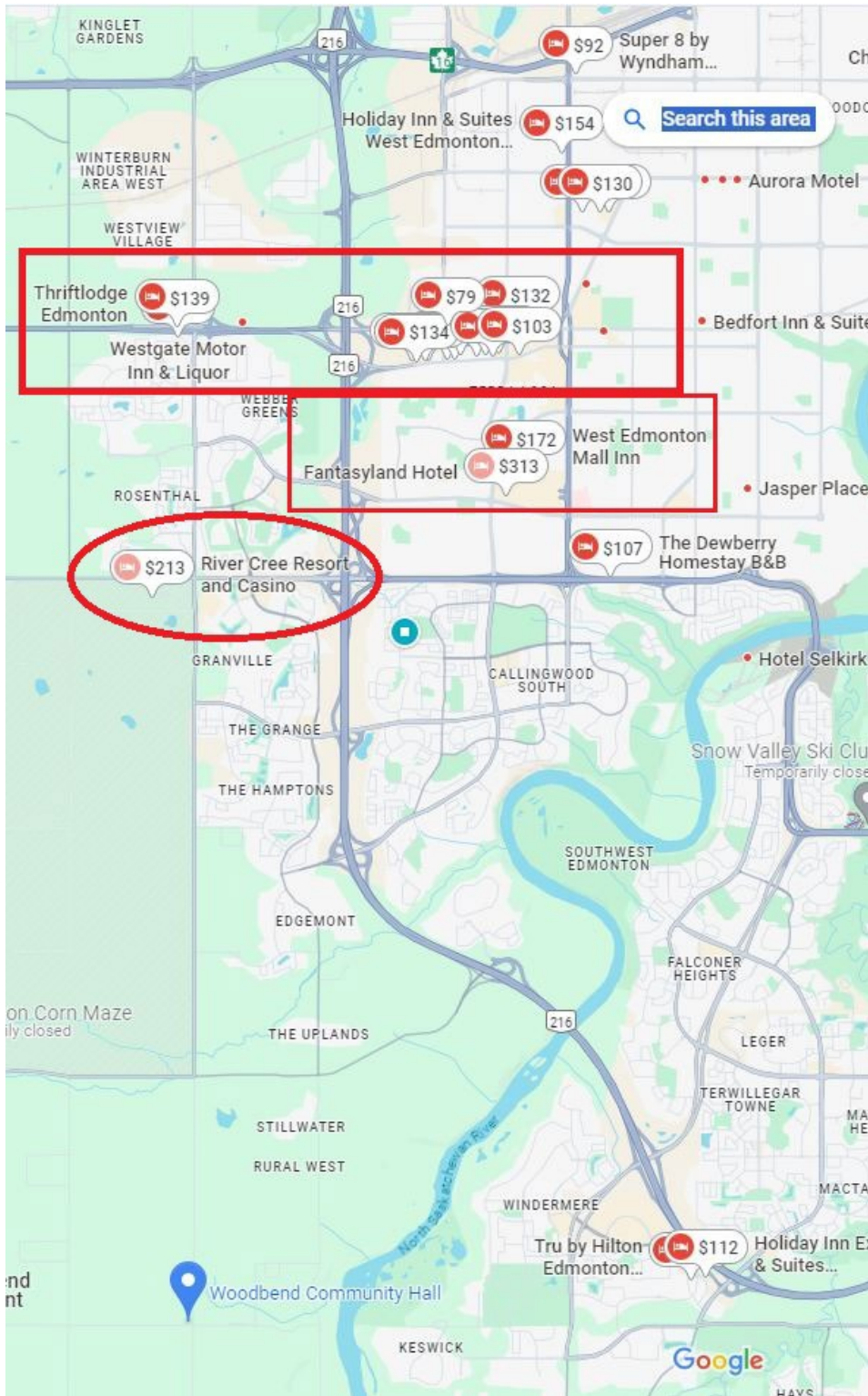


Figure 2: Hotels Close to Woodbend Hall – River Cree, West Ed Mall & Stony Plain Road 16A Corridor

There are also several potential Air BNB or VRBO locations in the West End region of the city. Prices vary depending on the number of guests and style of accommodation required. Check the listings!

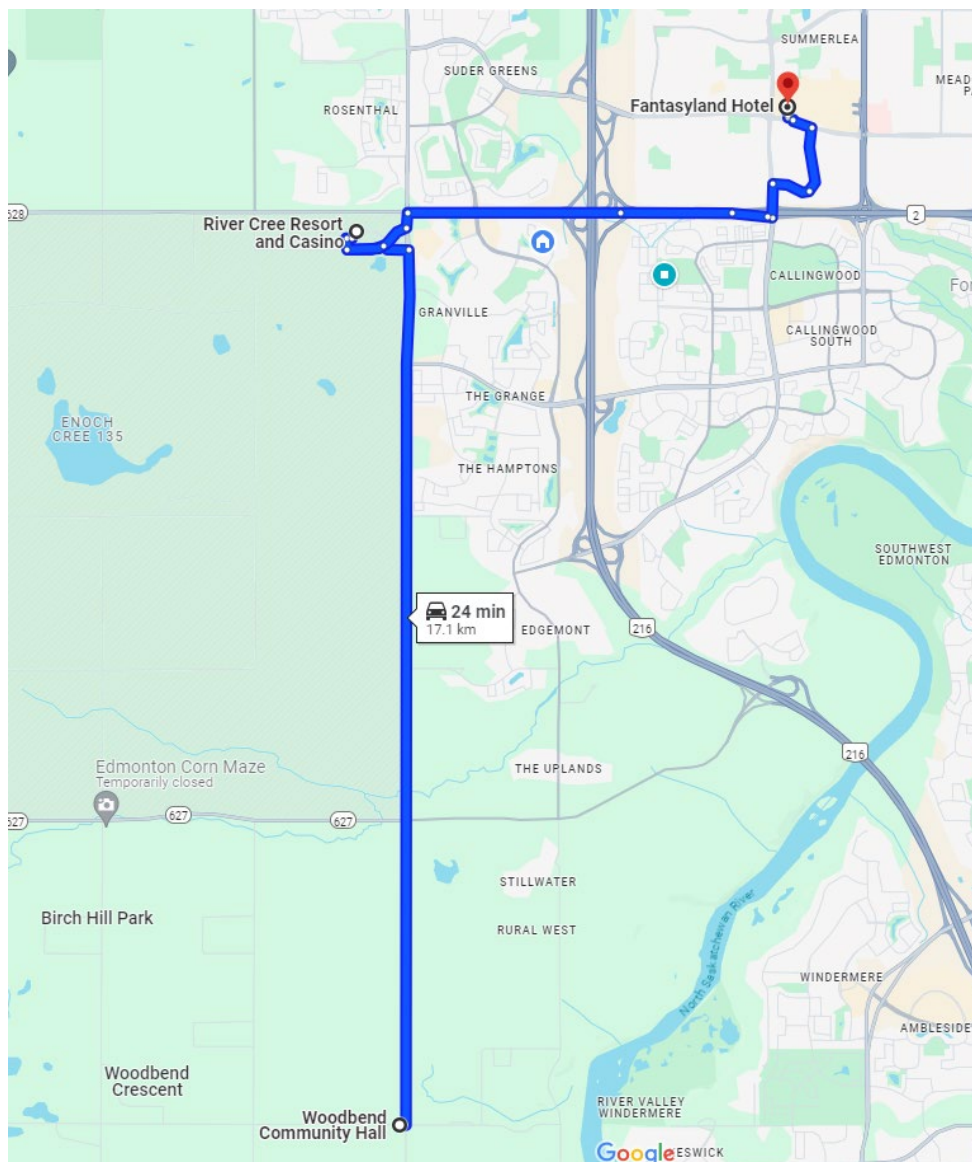


Figure 3: River Cree and Fantasy Land Hotel – Proximity to Woodbend Hall

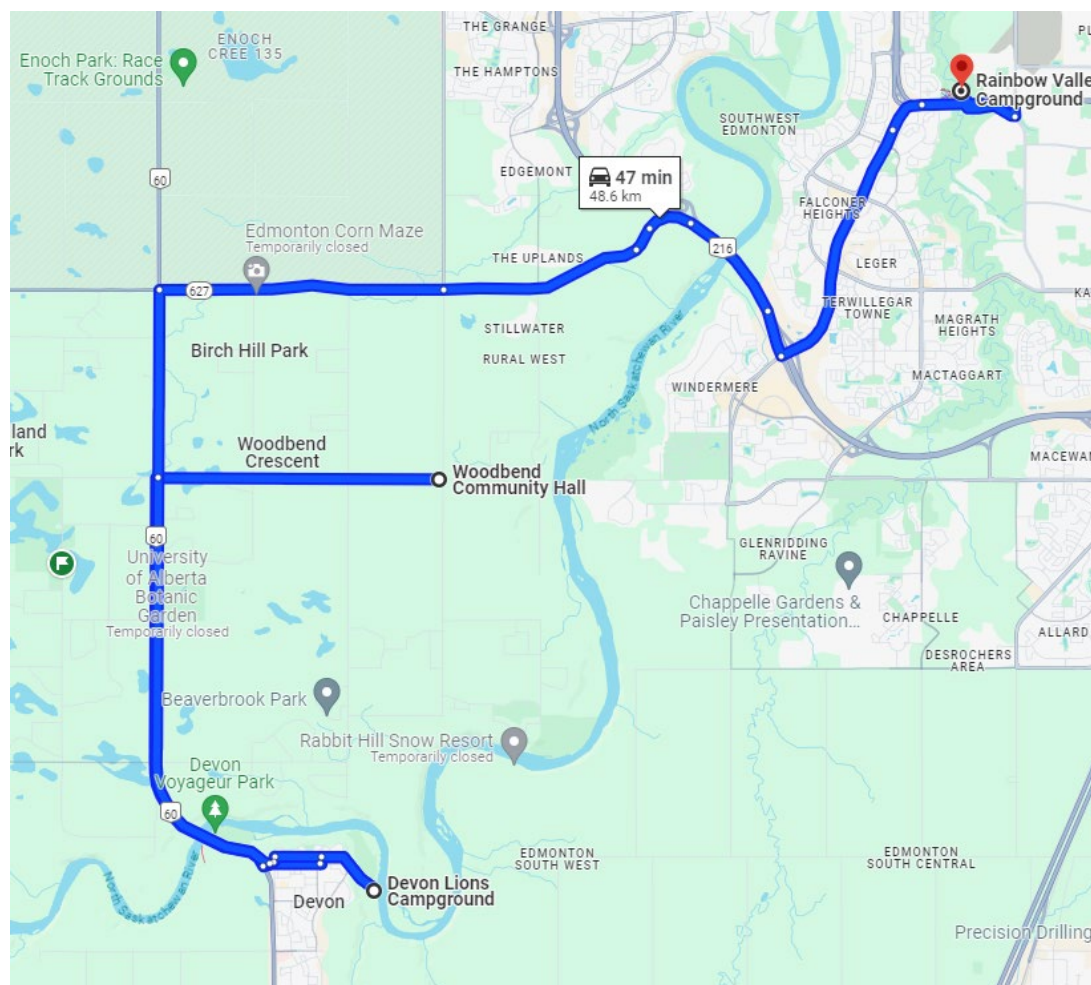


Figure 4: Devon and Rainbow Valley Campground locations – proximity to Woodbend Hall

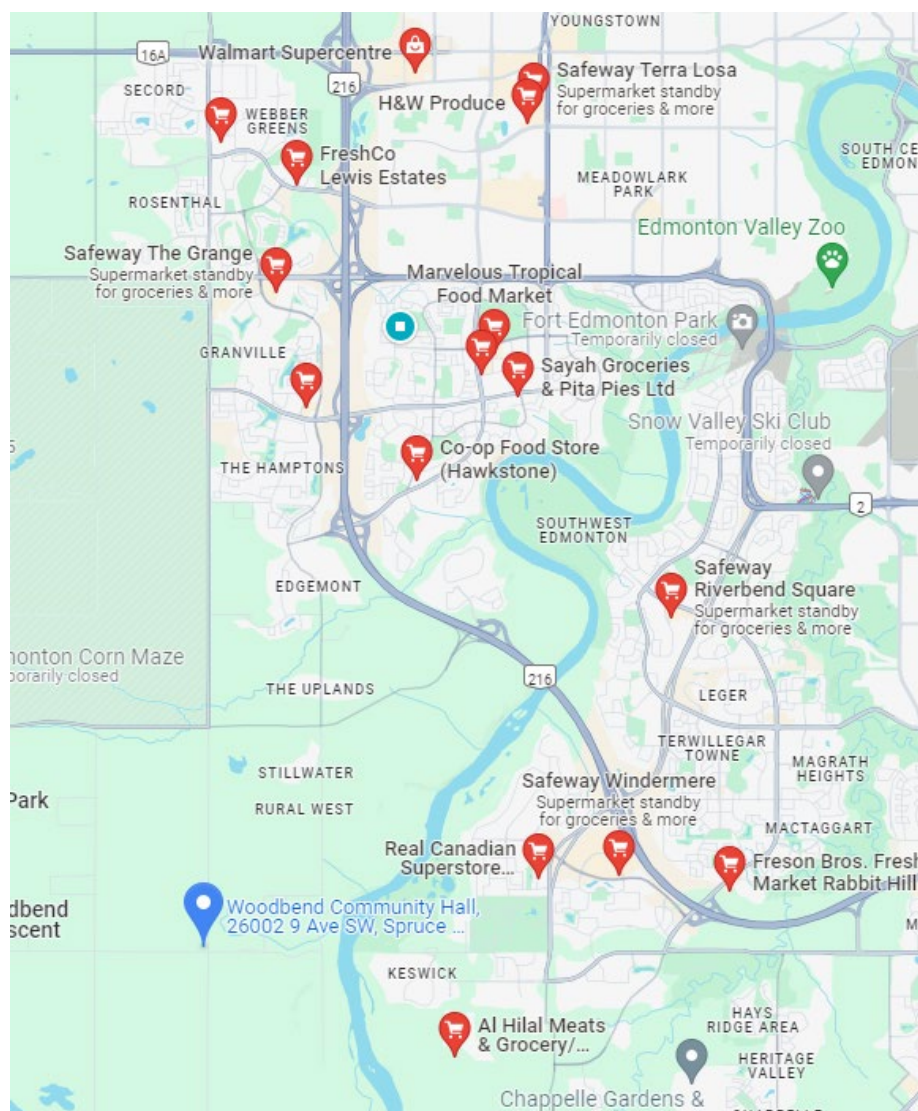


Figure 5: Grocery Retailers close to Woodbend Hall
